

WASHINGTON UROLOGY AMBULATORY SURGERY CENTER PATIENT RIGHTS

- You have the right to be informed of patient rights and receive a written copy of these rights no less than one day before treatment and care.
- You have the right to be treated and cared for with dignity and respect.
- You have the right to confidentiality, privacy, and security of your medical records.
- You have the right to review your own medical record and have access to information contained in your record in a reasonable time frame, except in certain circumstances specified by law.
- You have the right to be cared for in a safe setting, without all forms of abuse or harassment.
- You have the right to respect for your own personal values and beliefs.
- You have the right to be helped in a prompt & respectable manner, without neglect.
- You have the right to request family input in care decisions, in compliance with existing legal Advance Directives or other court-issued orders.
- You have the right to information regarding Advance Directives as well as the opportunity to formulate Advance Directives. These Advance Directives will not be honored during treatment at this facility in compliance with our policy.

- You or your representative have the right to participate in the development and implementation of your plan of care. This participation does **not** exclude refusing care and treatment or resolving problems with care decisions.
- You or your representative have a right to be informed of all aspects involved with your care.
- You have a right to have your representative and your own physician notified promptly if you are admitted to the hospital.
- You have the right, in the event that any investigative studies are suggested for your care, to be fully advised about such studies and fully consent to participate. If after being advised you do not provide full consent to participate, you and your medical records will not be included in the investigative study. No attempt will be made to coerce any patient hesitant to participate in research.
- You have the right, upon refusal to participate in any investigative study, to receive unhindered treatment and access to care.
- You have a right to file a grievance and to be informed of the process to review and resolve the grievance. (See information attached on how to file a grievance.)
- You have the right, when filing a grievance, to complain about care and treatment without fear of retribution or denial of care.
- When filing a grievance, you have the right to timely complaint resolution.

The physicians and staff are committed to providing quality healthcare to their patients. If you prefer another facility for your procedure, please discuss options for your care with your physician.
